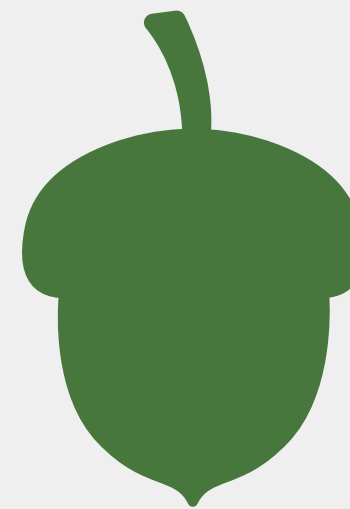

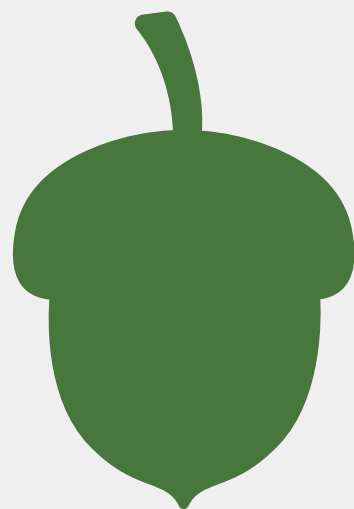

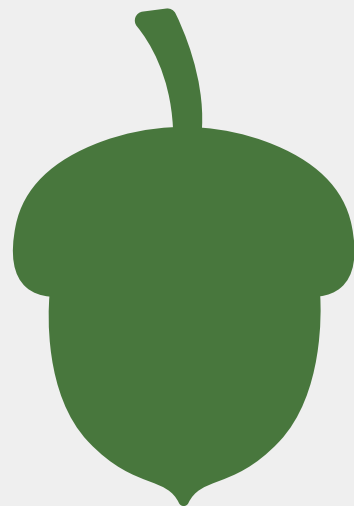




ABOUT US

- Design, creation and maintenance of school and urban gardens, edible forests and agroecological spaces.

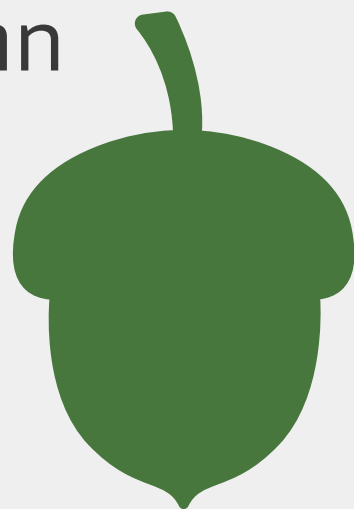




ABOUT NIGRÁN

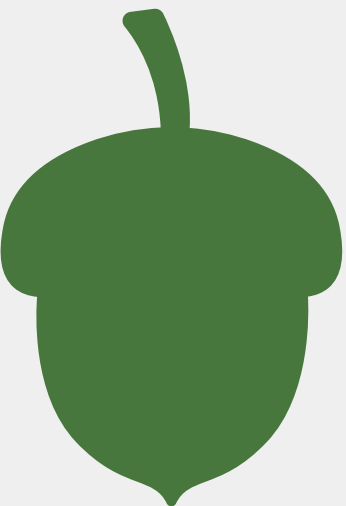
In Galicia it rains all year round and during autumn and winter there are usually storms. It is not the characteristic Mediterranean climate of Spain.





ABOUT THE PROJECT

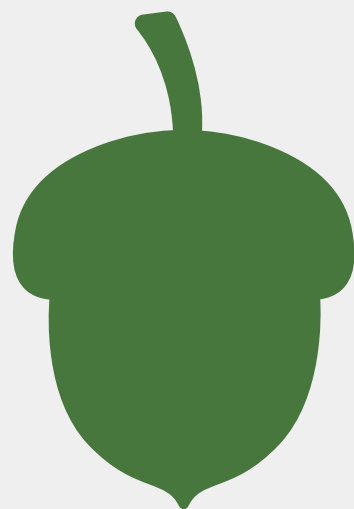
The project consists of revitalizing agricultural land through the creation of an edible forest with the participation of citizens, to encourage a sustainable management of the forest, and an effective and environmentally friendly food production. We seek to turn the forest into a place for citizens to spend their leisure time with environmental and educational activities; also a promotion of the natural and cultural heritage.






EDIBLE FOREST

We seek to revitalize the forest through the creation of an edible forest with the participation of citizens, to encourage sustainable forest management and effective and environmentally friendly food production. The project aims to provide the community with an edible forest to promote local and ecological production, as well as to empower citizens in self-cultivation and responsible consumption, and, finally, as well as promoting the consumption of harvest products.

PARTICIPANTS PROFILE

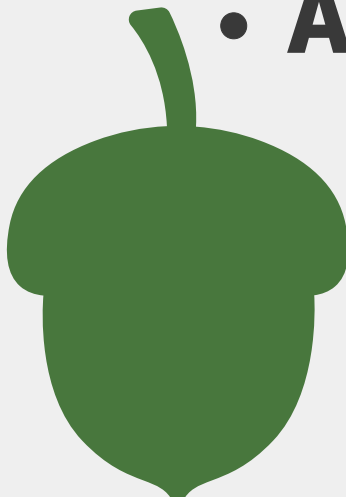
We are looking for people committed to the environment who seek to change the world towards a fairer and more sustainable model. Volunteers must know how to work in a team and seek cooperation.

ACOMMODATION

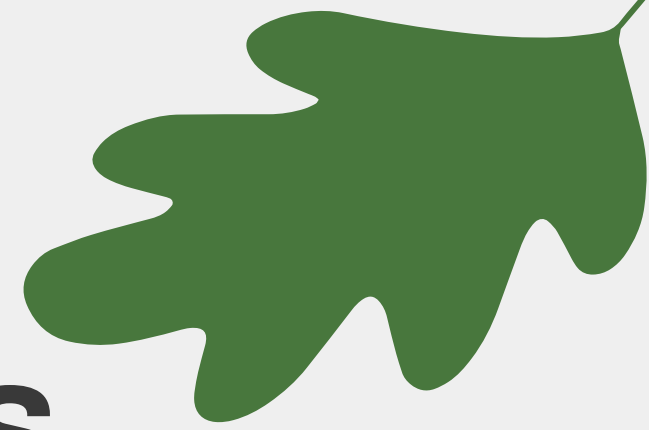
The volunteers will live in a:

- Transportation from the apartment to the workplace will sometimes be by public transport.





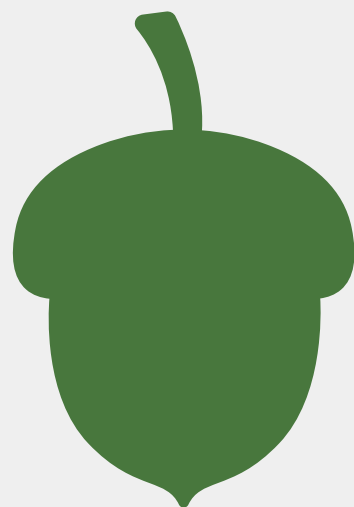
REQUIEREMENTS
